State Government draws on Victims of Crime Fund to extend Women's Domestic Violence Court Assistance Service

VSS delivers the Women's Domestic Violence Court Assistance Service to women who have experienced domestic abuse and need assistance to navigate legal matters regarding intervention orders and tenancy disputes.

VSS Chief Executive Julian Roffe said VSS helped over 450 women to navigate the legal process during 2015-16.

"VSS welcomes the State Government's decision to double the budget for our Women's Domestic Violence Court Assistance Service," Mr Roffe said.

"VSS has been responding to unprecedented demand for legal assistance from victims of domestic abuse and we anticipate that demand will continue to grow as more women become aware of the support services available to them to navigate their way through the Courts."

The State Government's announcement follows the COAG National Summit on Preventing Violence Against Women and their Children in Brisbane last week.
