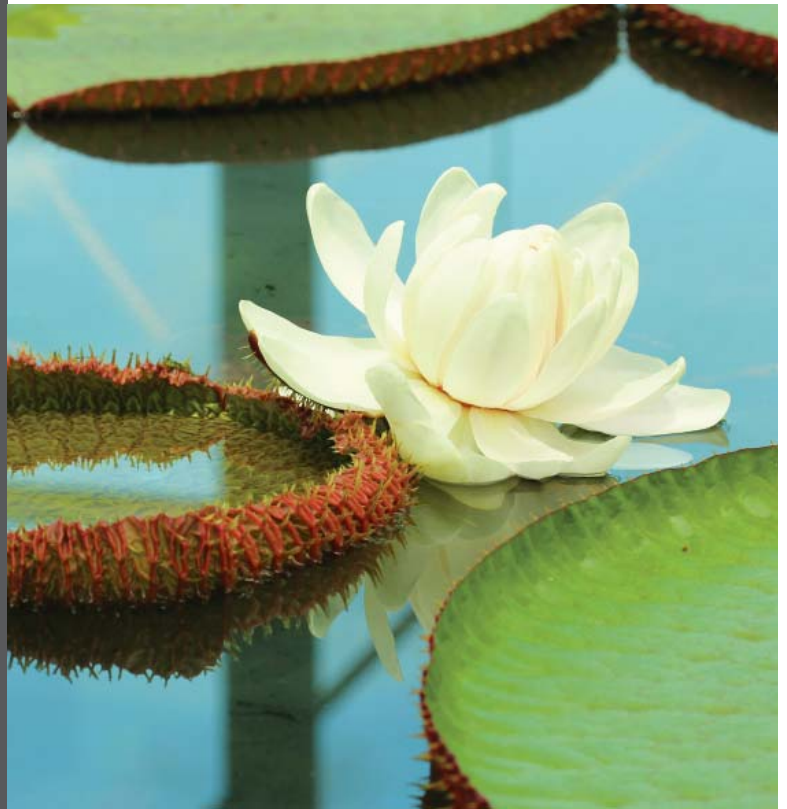

Royal Commission Support Services provides assistance and support for people who are engaging with the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Sexual Abuse. Institutions can include, but is not limited to, churches, schools, disability care providers, institutional care facilities or any organisation that has a responsibility for children outside of the home.

- Support and information on how to tell your story to the Royal Commission
- Face to face and telephone counselling
- Information about what to expect from the enquiry process
- Referrals to the Royal Commission and other agencies
- Support through legal processes
- Advocacy
- Pre and post support when giving evidence.
