2019 VICTIM WORKER OF THE YEAR AWARDS

Nominations close 5pm on Friday 4 October 2019

Nominations are now being sought for the 2019 **Volunteer** and **Professional** Victim Worker of the year awards.

The awards provide an opportunity to publicly show recognition to a volunteer and/or worker for 'making a difference' to victims' lives.

In choosing the recipients of the VSS Victim Workers of the Year Award, regard is given to the nominee's achievements in the year immediately prior to receiving the award, as well as their past achievements and ongoing contribution to the victim community in South Australia.

CATEGORIES

PROFESSIONAL are defined as "those who provide an extraordinary contribution in assisting crime victims as part of their paid employment".

Selection Criteria

1. Demonstrated excellence in their field
2. Demonstrated leadership, innovation and creativity
3. Community involvement
4. Future goals and likely impact
5. Degree of difficulty of the achievement and sacrifices made

VOLUNTEER are defined as "those who provide significant contribution in assisting crime victims outside of their paid employment"

Selection Criteria

1. Voluntary work beyond paid employment
2. Achievements as an individual or as part of a group or organisation
3. Significant contribution to the South Australian victim community
4. An inspirational role model for the victim community
5. Significant contribution at local community level
